FUNCTION & DUTIES:

Under the supervision of the Assistant Director of Second Language Curriculum Development, this position entails the responsibility of implementation, development and evaluation of a health & wellness curriculum, as well as coordinating regional activities in health, sports, and other recreational activities.

- Support and ensure high quality and culturally relevant education in Nunavik communities specifically with primary and secondary teachers in Physical and Health Education and Health & Wellness curriculum;
- Participate in the development of the programs and pedagogical material that are aligned to holistic approaches, Inuit culture, language and values;
- Support the KI competency-based and trauma informed programs and promote it with the school administrators, teachers and other staff members concerned;
- Lead training sessions / workshops with teachers in person or with technological support (virtual class, videoconference and others);
- Lead in the organization of special events and regional programs;
- Collaborate with team members across departments, local organizations, and other partners on the development of curriculum framework and materials;
- Follow up on school inventories of Physical and Health Education material;
- Support specific projects in these teaching fields using creative thinking and problem solving skills;
- Manage special annual events when necessary;
- Carry out related tasks at the discretion of the immediate

QUALIFICATIONS:

University degree in a relevant field; a CEGEP or vocational diploma or attestation will be considered if the applicant is a beneficiary of the James Bay and Northern Quebec Agreement.

The School Board may at its discretion disregard the above qualifications if it deems the application of a beneficiary of the James Bay and Northern Quebec Agreement (JBNQA) to be suitable and the person agrees to follow a training program determined by the Board
